

Colorectal Cancer




Colorectal cancer is the second most common cancer in Europe⁽²⁾

Pancreatic Cancer



Pancreatic cancer is the third biggest cancer killer in Europe⁽³⁾



One in ten cases of colorectal cancer is linked with alcohol consumption⁽⁷⁾

Alcohol Consumption



The consumption of 50 gr. of alcohol increases the risk of colorectal cancer by 10-20%⁽⁶⁾

Liver Cancer



Liver cancer is the 4th leading cause of cancer-related deaths worldwide, being the 2nd and 6th most common cause of cancer death in men and women, respectively(4)



Categories of alcohol-attributable cancer burden




Total alcohol-attributable life years lost: 1,880,490⁽⁵⁾

Oesophageal Cancer



Oesophageal cancer is the sixth largest cancer killer worldwide (8)



In terms of cancer risk one bottle of wine (10cl alcohol) is equivalent to smoking 5 cigarettes for men, and 10 cigarettes for women⁽⁹⁾
